\$35,000 in Grants Awarded to Area Nonprofits

4Front Foundation announces recipients of 2023 grant cycle

The second annual 4Front Foundation grant cycle saw nearly \$900,000 in grant applications from Michigan nonprofits. Out of the more than 70 applications, Child & Family Services of Northwestern Michigan, Kids Hope USA, All County Search and Rescue (ACSAR), Challenge Mountain of Walloon Hills, Inc., Family Promise of Tuscola County, Kalkaska County Commission on Aging, and Women's Resource Center for the Grand Traverse Area, came out on top as the 2023 grant recipients.
